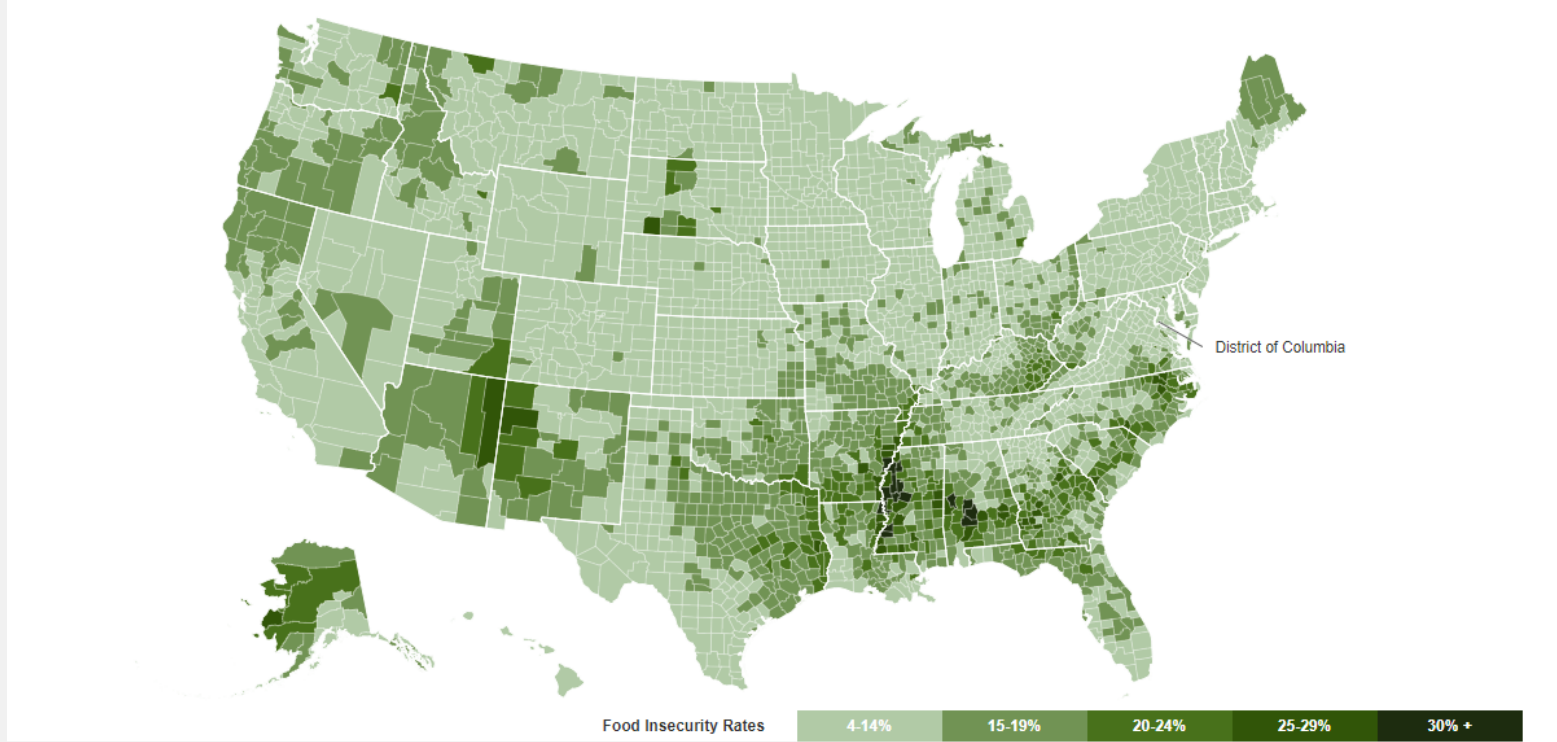

Americans Still Struggle

High employment masks economic challenges for low income populations.

Food insecurity among seniors has nearly doubled since 2001.

Federal food assistance programs are under threat.

Healthcare costs are crippling.

People don't understand hunger.

11 million children are food insecure.

Hunger spiked during the recession and only recently, returned to pre-recession levels.
